Company profile and history

History

- 1903 foundation of the metal works Gäbler as an valve company with an own foundry, located at the Woltorfer Straße in Peine, manufacturing of gun metal bushings and valves for the natural gas supply
- 1955 production of more than 40000 gas valves / month with 150 employees, 40 % of them women
- 1960 purchase of an old patent for the manufacturing of piston slide valves, complete new construction, improvement and adjustment to the requiries of the steel and iron industry for the supply of oxygen as an universal quick shut-off valve for technical gases and liquids.
- 1983 separation of the piston slide valve-branch of the company and foundation of a new company for the exclusive distribution and production of Gäbler-piston slide valves by Mrs. H. Gäbler.
- 1986 new production site for the H. Gäbler Armaturen GmbH within the industrial area East-Peine and manufacturing of the whole range of Gäbler-piston slide valves and spares
- 1998 Mrs. H. Gäbler retires and sells the company to Mr. Rüdiger Meves.
- 2007 Mr. Meves retires and sells the company to Mr. Fabian Ehlers, who is owner and managing director of the gasket company Rehm Dichtungen Ehlers GmbH, located just next to H. Gäbler Armaturen GmbH & Co. KG.
